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Stall Holder Guidelines

EVENT OVERVIEW

The annual Explore the Goldfields Community Expo is a celebration of everything local.

Local community groups and sporting organisations will have their chance to reach new residents and existing locals in an engaging way.

It's a great way to meet new people and gain new members and supporters for your organisation.

We encourage organisations to provide the public with information via workshop(s) and/or interactive displays.

When: Saturday 13th February 2021

Time: Setup from 7.30am for a 9am start – pack down from 12pm onwards

Where: Lord Forrest Complex, MacDonald Street

Cost: FREE for stall holders and community.

- **No stalls allowed to set up prior to 7.30am.**
- **Note please ensure it is a must to bring a 3m x 3m Marquee (due to lack of shade)**
- **No vehicle access.**
- **Note it is recommended to bring a trolley for setup and pack down.**

WHAT IS PROVIDED?

- A stall holder space (in lots of 3m x 3m)
- Venue
- Toilets
- Entertainment
- Information packs (site map)
- Event Management
- Advertising and Marketing of the event

WHAT IS NOT PROVIDED THAT YOU MAY REQUIRE?

- Tables with Table Cloths
- Chairs
- Receipt Books, pens and texta
- Cardboard boxes and rubbish bags/gloves and bins
- Blu tack/sticky tape/gaffer tape/cable ties
- Business cards or information brochures
- Posters/Easels
- Weather proof shade/tarps (if weather permits)
- Banners and signs

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will you be allowed to fundraise or sell products?

Fundraising is permitted at the event. Selling products is not permitted. Permission is to be sought from the City of Kalgoorlie Boulder, keeping in mind that this is an 'informative expo'.

Will there be food and drinks available?

Food and drinks will be available for purchase at this event.

Do you have give aways or promotional material?

Stallholders in the past have looked for ways to provide a unique presentation of their stall. We encourage you to provide current information packs (small and creative). Giveaways and promotional materials may include stickers, pens, magnets, bags, posters, drink bottles, booklets and so on.

Will you have a competition? (i.e. lucky dips, drawing comps...)

This is a great and potentially productive way of drawing people to your stall. We suggest stall holders have lucky dips, count the jelly beans in the jar, guess the weight, etc. We encourage you to think of a unique competition so that every stall offers something new to the patrons.

Will you be providing demonstrations?

If yes, the demonstrations must be executed within the boundary of your stall unless prior approved by the Event Coordinator.

Does your organisation have public liability insurance?

If you are an incorporated body, by rights you should already have Public Liability Insurance in order to provide a service to the public. If you do not, please contact the event coordinator as soon as possible.

When do the forms have to be returned?

Please ensure that you attach all relevant forms with your application.
