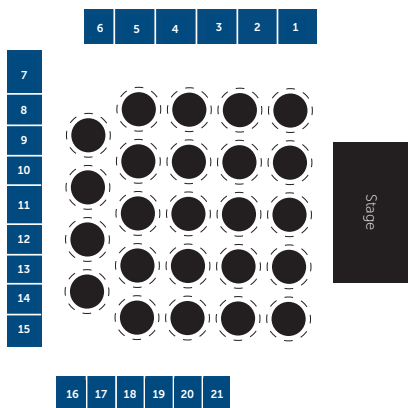

Curtin University - WA School of Mines

Curtin University Kalgoorlie Campus is a tertiary education provider providing engineering degrees through the WA School of Mines specialising in Mining and Metallurgy. We have operated in the Goldfields since 1902. As of 2019, Curtin University is ranked in the top 1% of universities globally according to the Academic Ranking of World Universities and aims to maintain this international standing. Currently, the campus is navigating a new strategic era. It will be undergoing both internal and external changes over the next 12 months with a stronger focus to contribute and engage with the local community. Curtin will be increasing Aboriginal engagement, and expanding its course offerings at the Kalgoorlie campus and will continue to run and support outreach programs which foster not only a wider local network but also a global network of potential stakeholders. We intend to promote our campus as a regionally based global hub with strong access and relationship to industry. We strive to maintain Curtin's international standing, reputation and history while encouraging not only potential students to study here but also remain in Kalgoorlie to live and work post studies. In the last 12 months, Curtin Kalgoorlie received external funding for three positions to aid in delivering the Work Integrated Learning program, Program Management of Demand-Driven research and a Professor of Practice in Mining Automation and Data Analysis roles. The curriculum has seen the introduction of Work Integrated Learning, focusing on Industry relevant training for students. Community engagement has been strong despite the challenges presented from Covid-19. A comprehensive and well-received re-orientation program was delivered to students throughout August, providing a greater experience to students of what Kalgoorlie and community have to offer and saw an increase in engagement both on campus and in community. WASM has delivered several campus tours to both primary and high school groups in the second half of the year. Schools travelled from local and further afield destinations, including Perth metropolitan and Wheatbelt areas. Our campus is open to schools for guided tours, community groups and the public are welcome onto campus for self-guided tours.

Nickel West is a fully integrated mine-to-market nickel business with over 3500 employees and contractors. All nickel operations are located in Western Australia and include one of Australia's largest flash furnaces, at the Kalgoorlie Nickel Smelter. Vimy Resources

The recently refreshed Definitive Feasibility Study and environmental approvals put the Mulga Rock Project at the forefront of the next wave of worldwide uranium projects.
