Benefits for your business

Networking

One of the greatest benefits of becoming a KBCCI member is being able to take advantage of the Chamber's extensive business network. Networking is the single most powerful marketing tactic to accelerate and sustain success for any individual or business. KBCCI acts as a catalyst via referrals and hosting a range of events. An example of this is our monthly Business After Hours. The format was changed in 2015 to be co-hosted by a minimum of 3 members. This has increased the attendance and diversified the mix of guests attending. With over 80 guests attending each month, these functions are a cost-effective way of promoting your business and an invaluable networking opportunity.

Promotion

Another member only benefit is the fact you can receive a massive 15% discount on advertising in the Chamber's own GE Directory Connect. GE Directory Connect is the ONLY locally owned and operated business directory in the Goldfields-Esperance region and is online at GEconnect.com.au. Being online you have the ability to update your details as your business changes, with your own log in.

Advice

An addition to the KBCCI in recent years is being able to provide one on one support to businesses and a variety of workshops via the SBDC's Business Local program.

You also have access to advice, training and support provided by CCIWA. The KBCCI pays over \$10,000 annually to have this service available to its members that employ less than 30 staff. This means KBCCI members have access to all CCIWA services such as the Employee Relations Advice, HR Consultancy, Apprenticeship & Trainee support and many other CCIWA tools to assist your business at no additional cost.

Working Together is a program that assist employers provide Aboriginal Youth work experience, traineeships and apprenticeships in collaboration with AWDC

Initiatives

For the Chamber to remain vibrant and truly represent a members commitment to the Chamber, it has invested and engaged in numerous new initiatives. Likened to seek.com our GE Jobs Connect is a platform to list local employment positions vacant to assist with growing your local workforce.

On the horizon, the Chamber is developing the Industry Capability Register which will be made available to major project proponents and others considering investment in the region.

\$355 inc GST annually. Instalment plans are available.

Who can be a member?

Membership is available to any business, organisation or government entity that wishes to support the Chamber's mission and take advantage of the services provided by the organisation.

How many businesses belong to the Chamber?

On average we have 470 members and this number is constantly growing.

Can the Chamber provide a Certificate of Membership?

Yes. A Certificate of Membership is presented after membership has been approved by our Executive committee at their monthly meetings.

Why do you ask how many employees I have?

KBCCI pays \$10,000 to CCIWA per annum to provide members with less than 30 employees' access to all CCIWA services. Members are now entitled to Employee Relations Advice & HR Consultancy, Apprenticeship & Trainee support plus other fee for service based services.

Can I participate in Chamber events and programs if I am not a Chamber Member yet?

Yes. There are nominal fee differences for members versus potential members for most programs and events, but all are invited to come and participate.
